Core Services

► Enhanced Information and Referral

Provides comprehensive resource information, education, follow-ups, and referrals by warm hand-offs.

► Person-Centered Options Counseling

Assists in identifying goals and needs through person-centered counseling and coordinating access to public and private-funded long-term services and services in the community.

► Short-Term Service Coordination

Streamlined access to services and supports for those at-risk of institutionalization, generally for 90 days or less, until a long term plan is in place.

► Person-Centered Transition Support

For individuals who are currently in a hospital, skilled nursing facility or other institution and wish to receive long term services and supports at home or in a community-based setting.
